- **Planning for the school year 2019-2020, Lakota Club, Cultural Competency Training, Honoring, Star Quilts, Wacipi**
- Medina Matonis stepping down from chairwoman due to personal reasons. Paul HollowHorn VP will be taking on her role. Medina will do a call in if needed, to help with advisor role for JOM board.
- **Lakota Club** – Medina will be taking kids to the handgame tourney Sept 20, 2019. Fundraising supplies are all upstairs in closet at Dupree School.  
**Handgames** – Rachel Barrera is willing to volunteer to go to handgames and dance group. Medina will attend the TECA WACIPI meeting and put school on the list.
- **Cultural Competency Training** November 13, 2019 – Jenny reached out to Jeremy Fields concerning the cost of matching our budget, since his training, as his fee is usually \$2,500.00. Jeremy said he would give us a discount and only charge us \$2,000.00.
- **Star Quilts** – 29 students. Budget will be \$250 per quilt/student. Jenny will get in touch with Dolly Jo Knife to see if she will be able to make the star quilts for the seniors graduating year 2020. Ask Dolly Jo what she will charge for up-to-4 colors; embroider their names and Class of 2020 on quilt. To off-set help with cost of star quilts JOM Board can ask the ABC Committee from CRST to help pay for the quilts.
- **Wacipi** – Figured out the Budget for the Wacipi and Honoring Ceremony. Paul HollowHorn will write to the ABC Committee and Youth Affairs to help with offset

cost of the participation t-shirts, Hoodies and Long Sleeve shirts. Potentially do another drawing or Art contest. Keep the same printing company as last years.

- **JOM Board Open to Public Term Meeting** – Medina Matonis and Megan Lafferty’s term will be up during the Open to Public Meeting in October 2019. Administration will be providing the drinks and food for the meeting.
- **JOM BOARD CONCERNS** – JOM Board discussed the concerns of the students that have been or are bullied by other children and staff at the Dupree School.
- **Concerns for Dupree School – What do you see at the school for change?**
  1. **More cameras** – Need more security cameras in the school. So when an occurrence happens, the staff doesn’t come back with the excuse of “well we didn’t catch it on camera”.
  2. **Staff**– Excuses as to why if the occurrence was not prevented. Instead of answers on how to fix it.
  3. **Need more staff who work with youth/culturally** – Have a trainee come and talk with the student without the teachers present to know and understand what the kids go thru on a daily basis and be able to open up, without retaliation from staff.
  4. **Teach the staff to become more culturally inclined on historical trauma** – as to why kids act out or not participate in class.
  5. **JOM BOARD** – to have a meeting with the Dupree School Board and talk about the bullying. Along with the parents that have issues and concerns from their child.
